ANTON ART CENTER ANNOUNCES 51st ANNUAL MICHIGAN ARTIST COMPETITION AND EXHIBITION

Mount Clemens, MI - The Anton Art Center proudly announces the return of the highly anticipated *Michigan Annual LI* fine art competition, now in its 51st year. The annual event, hosted by the Anton Art Center, showcases the talent of artists from across Michigan and offers a total of \$2,000 in awards. This year's competition is set to open on January 27, 2024, and will run until February 24, 2024.

The prestigious competition will be juried by Meighen Jackson, a teacher, curator and working artist, who has been an active part of the Detroit art community for almost forty years. The Opening Reception & Awards Ceremony, a highlight of the event, is scheduled to take place on January 27, 2024, from 2:00 pm to 4:00 pm, with refreshments provided by the Delta Kappa Gamma, Omega Chapter sorority.

Michigan Annual LI has become the Anton Art Center's most competitive professional-level exhibition, drawing top-tier artists from across the state. Stephanie Hazzard, Exhibition Manager, expresses, "This event is a cornerstone of our annual calendar, and the 51st edition promises to be as exciting as ever. It's a platform that celebrates the incredible diversity and talent of Michigan's fine art community."

Artists across Michigan were invited to submit up to two original artworks completed within the last two years. The competition accepted works in various mediums, ensuring a rich and diverse experience for visitors. Awards for the competition include:

1st Place: \$1,000 cash prize2nd Place: \$600 cash prize3rd Place: \$400 cash prize
