



# MACOMB COUNTY BIENNIAL PRIMARY STUDENT SHOW • GRADES K-6 ANTON ART CENTER • 2022 GUIDELINES

#### **ENRTY DEADLINE**

All materials (artwork(s), entry fee(s), and entry form) must be submitted in person on **Thursday, April 14<sup>th</sup>**, **2022**, **between 11am-3pm**. Guidelines, Entry List, School Codes, and Artwork Labels are available for download/print at <a href="https://www.theartcenter.org/artist-opportunities">www.theartcenter.org/artist-opportunities</a>. Please call ahead if you have any questions or need an alternative delivery time.

#### **ENTRY PROCEDURE**

All students in grades K-6 currently enrolled in private, parochial, public, or homeschool in Macomb County are eligible to enter this professional exhibit through their art teacher only. **Up to 15 pieces maximum per school may be submitted for a fee of \$1 per artwork.** Entry list and fee(s) must be received prior to or at the time of artwork delivery.

### **PRESENTATION**

All submitted artwork that meets the guidelines will be displayed and eligible for jurying. Art teachers are responsible for selecting and preparing the artworks for submission/delivery.

All mediums are acceptable. Maximum size is 18 x 24 inches in any direction for 2-D and 3-D artwork. Please refrain from submitting fragile pieces. All work should be sturdy and suitable for hanging or pedestal. Standard weight mat board in white or black only is required (or other pre-approved hanging system for canvas, panel, sculpture, etc.)

All artwork must be original. Artwork submitted should be part of the current school year curriculum. Works that do not meet standard presentation guidelines will not be exhibited. No frames, sharp objects, or wet paint. Wood panel is acceptable; matting not required. Display props for jewelry are allowed. *Work previously exhibited at the Anton Art Center is ineligible, as per gallery policy.* 

**CODE NUMBER & ARTWORK LABELS:** A code number is assigned to each school registering for this exhibit. If you are a homeschool leader or don't know your code number, please contact the Exhibition Manager. Your code must be on your inventory form and on each artwork label.

Your school's code must be on your inventory form and on all artwork labels. For all 2-D works, a label must be securely fixed (taped or glued) to the lower right **FRONT** corner (either on the mat board or secured to the backside of a canvas, panel, etc.to hang down. For all 3-D works, fasten with a string or include a label by envelope or other way to use for display.

**ENTRY LIST & FEE**: Complete the Entry List for all submitted artworks and make a copy for your records. Completed forms must be delivered in advance or with the artwork upon receipt. Please submit in advance or with the artwork the entry fee payment by cash, check (payable to *Anton Art Center*), by PayPal on our website (<a href="www.theartcenter.org/submita-payment">www.theartcenter.org/submita-payment</a>), or call the office to charge credit.

#### **AWARDS**

- Best of Grade awards, a \$30, \$25, or \$20 art supply gift certificate, will be given to three outstanding works in each grade (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> prizes).
- Merit Ribbons may be awarded to selected outstanding work in for each grade at the jurors' discretion.
- Certificates will be awarded to all exhibiting artists, given to instructors at the conclusion of the exhibit.













Selection Notes: All work will be juried in groups by grade. Jurors are looking for originality, intention, and technical ability. All submitted artworks must be original, part of the current school year curriculum, and completed and entered under the supervision of an art teacher. Prize winning works will be communicated to participating teachers.

HOLD HARMLESS ENTRY AGREEMENT: The Anton Art Center, its agents and employees are not responsible for damaged, lost, or stolen artwork that is submitted to the Macomb County Primary Student Show. Submission of artwork constitutes acceptance of these policies and guidelines.
