



Boll History Gallery Invitation

Thank you for your interest in the Anton Art Center!

The Boll History Gallery, generously funded by John and Marlene Boll, Sr., is a featured space adjoining the main gallery space on the first floor, which is accessible by stairs and elevator. The space measures approximately 13 by 14 feet, or 221 square feet, with three east-facing windows.

In 2019, the Anton Art Center celebrated fifty years as Macomb County's leading non-profit art organization housed in an original historic Carnegie Library building built in 1904, in Downtown Mount Clemens, Michigan. Gallery admission is free and open to the public. Parking is available by street or meter lot, and is free after 6pm and on weekends.

The history display is typically open for the duration of a main gallery exhibit, usually around 4-8 weeks or longer, and can feature either a complete or select number of items representative of the larger collection of local or regional historical significance. Thematically pairing a history exhibit with the art gallery exhibit is not required.

Displaying a collection at our location shares a piece of history with the community while also helping to promote the lending group to a receptive public. Some of the groups that have collaborated with us in recent years include: the Eleanor & Edsel Ford House, Pewabic Pottery, Great Lakes Lace Group, Packard Proving Grounds, Selfridge Air Museum, Meadow Brook Hall, the Mount Clemens Library, the County of Macomb, Ada & Ike Eisenfeld, Macomb Community College, Sterling Heights Historical Commission, Friends of Ray Township Library & Historical Society, and Wayne State University.

The historic exhibits provide an educational experience and generally do not list items for sale, but often include take-away literature. A display statement is featured with the display, usually no longer than one page. There is no fee to reserve or rent the space.
